6	Proposed Electric Service Schedule Number 34
7	Renewable Energy Tariff.

We support these 20 changes. 21 And, you know, we especially support the 2.2 fact that there is a methodology that allows for 23 pricing and other methodologies to come into the Commission for your approval that may be outside the 24 25 scope of 32's (sic) pricing methodology.
