Dear Mr. Lively,

The Commission reviewed the July 26, 2016 initial filing by PacifiCorp, doing business as Rocky Mountain Power (PacifiCorp), proposing changes to its Cool Keeper Air Conditioner Direct Load Control Program (Program) administered through Electric Service Schedule No. 114. PacifiCorp's initial filing proposed revisions to Sheet Nos. 114.1 and 114.2; canceled Sheet Nos. 114.3, 114.4, and 114.5; and requested an effective date of September 1, 2016. The Commission also reviewed: PacifiCorp's July 28, 2016 filing requesting an extended comment period and a December 1, 2016 effective date for the proposed Schedule 114 revisions; its November 3, 2016 filing updating Sheet Nos. 114.1 and 114.2; and its November 8, 2016 filing proposing a correction to Sheet No. 114.1 filed on November 3, 2016.

The Commission reviewed the comments the Division of Public Utilities (Division) filed on September 26, 2016 and November 14, 2016 and the comments the Office of Consumer Services (Office) filed on September 30, 2016. The Division recommends the Commission approve the changes to Schedule 114. According to the Division, the proposed changes to the Program are administrative in nature and do not modify the Program's purpose. The Office recommends the Commission approve the proposed modifications to Schedule 114 and acknowledges the revisions are intended to more clearly define the Program and will not result in any material change. Based on the Commission's review of PacifiCorp's filings and the Division's and the Office's recommendations, the changes to Sheet Nos. 114.1 and 114.2, as filed on November 8, 2016 and November 3, 2016, respectively and the cancellation of Sheet Nos. 114.3, 114.4, and 114.5, as filed on July 26, 2016, are approved effective December 1, 2016.
