ELECTRIC SERVICE SCHEDULE NO. 110

STATE OF UTAH

New Homes Program

APPLICABLE: All newly constructed residences in all territory served by Company in the state of Utah billed on Schedules 1, 2 and 3.

PURPOSE: Reduce newly connected residential electric loads, including summer peak loads, by encouraging quality construction practices through the adoption of high efficiency cooling equipment and well-designed air-conditioning systems, as well as promoting high-efficiency insulation, windows and appliances and the installation of ENERGY STAR qualified lighting.

DESCRIPTION: Incentives will be provided to participating builders who construct new single family homes and multi-family dwellings with improved energy efficiency measures listed in Table 1 of this schedule. Incentives will be paid after the home is completed pursuant to the terms of this schedule and Program Requirements. Incentives will be sent to the person or company listed on the builder application.

QUALIFYING EQUIPMENT: Energy efficiency measures eligible for incentives are listed in Table 1.

PROVISIONS OF SERVICE: To be eligible for incentives, builder must comply with all terms and conditions of this schedule and Program requirements.

Incentive applications must be submitted within 180 days from the completion date of the home. Completion date is defined as the date upon which the certificate of occupancy is issued by the applicable municipality for the subject residence, or other alternative as deemed acceptable by the Company.

Qualifying equipment receiving incentives under the New Homes Program may not receive equipment purchase and installation incentives under other Company programs.

Incentives are limited to one energy-efficient whole home measure in each newly constructed, dwelling unit. Builders may be eligible for multiple Standalone measures for each newly constructed, dwelling unit with a maximum of two (2) qualifying measures per measure type with the exception of lighting, HVAC-quality installation, exterior wall upgrade and R-5 windows.
