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

Dear Commissioners,

I oppose the recent proposal from Rocky Mountain Power; Advice No. 16-13" filed Nov. 9, 2016 that would change the rate structure for roofing solar customers. I urge the Public Service Commission to suspend the tariff and prevent it from effect on December 9, as Rocky Mountain Power has proposed. Rocky Mountain Power should be required to use the normal rate-making process.

I believe it is unfair for Rocky Mountain Power to raise rates for customers who wish to use rooftop solar: I am deeply concerned about the future of our planet and I believe solar gives people access to a cleaner more reliable source of energy. My family and I have been associated with Utah Power, Rocky Mtn Power, Pacific Corp. for over 75 years. During those years your corporations have maintained a successful dominium and control over electrical power for our lives, via mandate of Public Service Commissions. That was our choice to have the privilege and luxury of having on demand electrical service.

In the 1970's , I made the decision to install in a new home , I built , as a licensed home builder for myself--- under your staff advisement, a home in Pleasant Grove, heated and cooled with heat pumps. Within 6-9 months , the electrical consumption residential rate had advanced 30% and a few months later nearly doubled. At that time I was under way to raise my family, and to meet monthly billings, and house mortgage.

I borrowed extra funds to eliminate the heating portion of the heat pumps and installed natural gas forced are heating. WHY? COST!!!!!!!!!!!!

I have lived under your utility domination ever since.

PLEASE BE NOTIFIED THAT I STERNLY OBJECT TO YOUR NOVEMBER 9, 2016 REQUEST FOR A NET METERING TARIFF. I DO NOT BELIEVE THAT EXTRA COST IS IN ANY WAY JUSTIFIED OR NEEDED. YOUR OBJECTIVE IS TO INCREASE YOUR NET PROFITS.. EVEN THOUGH YOU STATE IN YOUR LETTER THAT BECAUSE OF OUR EARLIER INVESTMENT OF \$30,000 FOR SOLAR PANNELLED ELECTRICAL POWER, I WILL NOT BE ASSESSED THIS TARIFF. THERE IS NO GUARANTEE THAT YOU WON'T REVERSE YOUR PRE DECEMBER 9, 2016 DECISION.

I BELIEVE THAT YOU ARE STIFFLING THE INSTALLATION BY OTHERS WITH SOLAR POWER. YOUR DECISION IS ELIMINATING THE DESIRE AND ABILITY FOR OTHERS TO INVEST IN SOLAR POSSIBILITIES.
