On December 13, 2016 the Commission issued a bench order approving the Settlement Stipulation filed on November 23, 2016 in the above referenced matter. Paragraph 14 of the Settlement Stipulation provides that the Parties agree to revise Electric Service Schedule No. 107, Solar Incentive Program, by deleting Special Condition 8 in its entirety.

Accordingly, enclosed for filing are originals and file copies of proposed tariff sheets associated with Tariff P.S.C.U. No. 50 of PacifiCorp, d.b.a Rocky Mountain Power, applicable to electric service in the State of Utah. The Company respectfully requests an effective date of December 30, 2016 for the proposed tariff changes.
