Subject: Response to Docket No. 19-030-T01

Dear Mr. Widerburg,

On behalf of the Moon Lake Electric Association, inc., I am providing the following response to docket order #17-030-T001, which requests Moon Lake Electric Association, Inc. to file current tariffs and demonstrate compliance with applicable law. Below are the requested reports outlined in the above noted docket order.

- 1. A complete copy of Moon Lake's currently effective tariff;
- 2. A record of all changes or revisions to Moon Lake's tariff since January 1, 2016;
- 3. A record of the actions Moon Lake's board of directors has taken to approve any changes or revisions to the tariff since January 1, 2016;
- 4. A record of all public meetings, and corresponding public notices, Moon Lake has held since January 1, 2016 pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 54-7-12(7)(c); and
- 5. To the extent Moon Lake's currently effective tariff contains revisions that were made effective without meeting all statutory requirements, Moon Lake's plan for rectifying the deficiency or deficiencies, including but not necessarily limited to any public meetings Moon Lake intends to hold.

Moon lake's current effective Electric Service Regulations and Rate Tariffs were accepted by the PSC on May 1, 2016. In 2017 Moon Lake went through the process of proposing necessary changes to the electric service regulations and rate tariffs to the board of directors. These changes were proposed to the Moon Lake board of directors on May 10, 2017 (Board Meeting attached). After the board approved the proposed changes, Mr. Haslem with Moon Lake made contact with you about the options for getting these proposed changes accepted and filed. It was clear in your response letter dated July 10, 2017 that the standard process needs to be followed in accordance with state law.



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On May 8, 2019, Moon Lake's board of directors approved the proposed changes for both rate tariffs and the regulations, including those recommended changes from May 10, 2017. This approval was subject to public hearings to be held on May 22, 2019 in Roosevelt, Utah and May 23, 2019 in Rangely, Colorado (Notice of Public Hearings Attached). The purchased display was printed in the Vernal Express, as well as, the Uintah Basin Standard newspapers on May 14, 2019 and May 21, 2019. Based on these public hearings there was no significant opposition to the proposed changes.

Included with this transmittal are the various reports that address all of the requests outlined in the Docket Order. The reline versions take the currently filed 2016 regulations and tariff and demonstrate the changes that were reviewed and approved by the board of directors in 2019. There are also clean versions of the 2019 regulations and rate tariffs. The other documents submitted are to provide evidence to support that MLEA followed the process as outlined in the applicable state laws for advertising and hold public hearings to review recommended changes.

As a summary to the questions and reports requested in Docket No. 17-030-T01, the above description and the provided materials with this correspondence should provide all the necessary reporting and identification of changes to rate tariffs and electric regulations up to the effective date of July 1, 2019.
