

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Pursuant to Utah Administrative Code R746-430-2(2)(c)(i) and R746-440-1(2)(a), PacifiCorp, doing business as Rocky Mountain Power (“Rocky Mountain Power” or “Company”), hereby provides public notice that it intends to file a request for approval of a resource decision (“Request”) relating to the Company’s decision to upgrade or “repower” most of its wind resources. Repowering will involve the replacement of the existing machine heads including the nacelle, hub and rotor. The Company is planning to upgrade its wind facilities in Wyoming including Glenrock I, Glenrock III, Rolling Hills, Seven Mile Hill I, Seven Mile Hill II, High Plains, McFadden Ridge, and Dunlap, the Leaning Juniper facility in Oregon, and the Marengo I,

Marengo II, and Goodnoe Hills facilities in Washington. The Company is proposing to repower of its 13 wind facilities, representing 999.1 megawatts of installed wind capacity. Broken down by state, this consists of eight facilities in Wyoming comprising 594 megawatts, one facility in Oregon of 100.5 megawatts, and three facilities in Washington comprising 304.6 megawatts. Rocky Mountain Power will file the Request on June 30, 2017. 
