The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed PacifiCorp's, dba Rocky Mountain Power, March 30, 2018 filing of its 2017 Annual Report of the Blue Sky Program (Report). The PSC also reviewed the April 30, 2018 comments filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) and Utah Clean Energy (UCE).

The DPU concluded the report complies with PSC orders and adheres to PSC reporting requirements. Therefore the DPU recommends the PSC acknowledge the Report. In addition, the DPU expresses concern with the lack of progress on certain Blue Sky solar projects initiated in 2014 and 2015 and would like to see these projects nearing completion in 2018.

UCE concluded the Report is complete and provided comments and recommendations on various aspects of the Blue Sky Program (Program) including the cost of Renewable Energy Certificates and Program block prices, standards and criteria for Program grants, future Program customer survey content, and Program monitoring.

Based on the PSC's review of the Report and recommendations filed by the DPU and UCE, the PSC acknowledges the Report as complying with the PSC reporting requirements.
