The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed the Division of Public Utilities' (DPU) Memorandum and Calendar Year 2017 Audit Report (Audit Report) of Rocky Mountain Power's Blue Sky Program (Program) filed on October 15, 2018. The DPU states the intent of the audit was to review the revenues and expenses of the Program as reported by PacifiCorp for the year ended December 2017 and test the Program's compliance with PSC Orders and Tariff Schedules 70 and 72. The DPU's Audit Report states the Program's revenues, disbursements, and expenses appear to be properly stated, and PacifiCorp appears to be in compliance with regulatory and reporting requirements. The DPU concludes the Program follows good business practices and uses adequate and practical accounting and controls.

The PSC issued a Notice of Filing and Comment Period on October 17, 2018, inviting comments on the Audit Report by November 15, 2018. No comments were filed.
