The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed the Division of Public Utilities' (DPU) Calendar Year 2018 Report ("Report") of the Home Electric Lifeline Program ("Program") filed on July 1, 2019. The Report was filed pursuant to the PSC's November 23, 2005 Report and Order in Docket Nos. 03-035-01 and 04-035-21.

The Report states the Program is administered reasonably and the recipients are benefiting without overly burdening ratepayers or PacifiCorp. According to the DPU, the Program evaluation is inconclusive in terms of the success and effectiveness of the Program. The DPU recommends no further action.

The PSC issued a Notice of Filing and Comment Period on July 2, 2019, inviting comments and reply comments on the report by July 31, 2019, and August 15, 2019, respectively. No comments were filed. The PSC concludes the DPU's Calendar Year 2018 Report of the Home Electric Lifeline Program complies with the PSC's reporting requirements in this matter.
