In accordance with applicable law and orders of the Public Service Commission (“PSC”), PacifiCorp dba Rocky Mountain Power (“PacifiCorp”) currently applies the value of expiring excess generation credits under Schedule 135 to the Home Electric Lifeline Program. In commenting on PacifiCorp’s most recently filed Customer Owned Generation and Net Metering Report, numerous parties asserted the excess credits should be applied to a different program.¹

The PSC gives notice it has opened this docket for the purpose of considering alternative uses of expiring excess generation credits under Schedule 135. Any interested person or party may submit comments to the PSC on this issue by **Thursday, November 8, 2018** and may submit reply comments by **Tuesday, November 27, 2018**.
