The Public Service Commission of Utah (PSC) reviewed the February 1, 2019 compliance filing by PacifiCorp, proposing changes to Sheet No. 3.2 of Electric Service Schedule No. 3, Low Income Lifeline Program – Residential Service Optional for Qualifying Customers (Schedule 3). Pursuant to the PSC's January 11, 2019 Order in this docket (Order), PacifiCorp proposes to modify Schedule 3 to include an excess customer generation credit of a maximum of \$6.80 during the April 2019 billing cycle. PacifiCorp requests the proposed changes take effect April 1, 2019.

The PSC also reviewed the Division of Public Utilities' (DPU) February 7, 2019 comments. The DPU concludes that PacifiCorp's proposal is reasonable and that the proposed changes to Sheet No. 3.2 comply with the Order. The DPU recommends the PSC approve PacifiCorp's proposed changes to Sheet No. 3.2 with the condition that PacifiCorp satisfy the reporting requirement identified in the Order.

Based on the PSC's review of the filing and the DPU's comments and recommendations, the proposed revisions to Sheet No. 3.2 are approved, effective April 1, 2019.
