Rocky Mountain Power (the “Company”), is the tariff sheet to effectuate compliance with the Order issued by the Public Service Commission of Utah (“Commission”) in this docket on November 9, 2018, applicable to electric service in the State of Utah (“Order”). Pursuant to the requirement of Rule R746-405-2(D), the Company states that the proposed tariff sheet does not constitute a violation of state law or Commission rule. Consistent with the Settlement Stipulation approved in the Order, the Company respectfully requests an effective date of January 1, 2019 for these changes.

Federal Tax Act Adjustment

Original Sheet No. 197.1 contains both the applicable rates for May 1, 2018 through December 31, 2018, along with the rates beginning January 1, 2019 (“2019 and After”) to credit customers for the annual amount of \$61 million. The workpapers used to calculate the percentage amounts showing in the First Revision of Sheet No. 197.1 were provided in Exhibit A that accompanied the Company’s compliance filing on May 4, 2018.




