The Public Service Commission of Utah ("PSC") reviewed the November 16, 2018 filing by PacifiCorp, doing business as Rocky Mountain Power ("PacifiCorp"), proposing changes to Sheet No. 197.1 of Electric Service Schedule 197, Federal Tax Act Adjustment. PacifiCorp represents the proposed revisions comply with the PSC's November 9, 2018 Order Approving Settlement Stipulation ("Order") in Docket Nos. 17-035-69 and 16-035-36. Pursuant to the Order, the revisions reflect an annual \$61 million rate reduction refunded over a 12-month period. PacifiCorp requests these changes take effect January 1, 2019.

The PSC also reviewed the comments filed by the Division of Public Utilities ("DPU") on December 3, 2018. The DPU concludes the filing and the proposed changes to Sheet No. 197.1 are consistent with the Order. The DPU recommends the PSC acknowledge PacifiCorp's proposed changes as filed.

Based on the PSC's review of the filing and the DPU's comments and recommendations, the proposed revisions to Tariff Sheet No. 197.1 are approved, effective January 1, 2019.
