**RE: MT. WHEELER POWER, INC.  
REQUEST FOR EXEMPTION FROM COMMISSION  
JURISDICTION**

Ladies or Gentlemen:

This is a request from Mt. Wheeler Power, Inc., a Nevada Non-Profit Cooperative Corporation, for exemption from Commission Jurisdiction pursuant to Utah Code 54-2-202.

Pursuant to Utah Code 54-2-202:

1. Mt. Wheeler Power, Inc., is an out-of-state distribution electrical cooperative, which is incorporated and based in the State of Nevada, a State adjoining Utah;
2. Mt. Wheeler Power has not previously been headquartered or maintained its principal place of business in Utah;
3. Mt. Wheeler Power serves less than 25,000 total customers;
4. Mt. Wheeler Power provides electric services to consumers in Utah, but less than 20% of its total power sales are based in Utah; and



5. Mt. Wheeler Power certifies that it is subject to the applicable laws, rules, and regulations of the State of Nevada, where Mt. Wheeler Power's principal place of business is located.

As Mt. Wheeler Power meets all of the requirements for an exemption from commission jurisdiction, Mt. Wheeler Power respectfully requests that the Commission exempt Mt. Wheeler Power from its' jurisdiction pursuant to Utah Code 54-2-202.
