The Public Service Commission ("PSC") reviewed PacifiCorp's March 29, 2019 filing of its 2018 Annual Report of the Blue Sky Program ("Report") and its updated 2018 Annual Report of the Blue Sky Program ("Updated Report") filed May 14, 2019. The PSC also reviewed the April 29, 2019 comments filed by the Division of Public Utilities ("DPU").

The DPU concluded the Report substantially complies with PSC orders and adheres to PSC reporting requirements with the exception that the Report failed to provide the number of project applications received and the number rejected as required by the PSC's order in Docket No. 00-035-T01 dated March 21, 2008.
