The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed the Division of Public Utilities' (DPU) Memorandum and its calendar year 2018 Audit Report ("Audit Report") of Rocky Mountain Power's (RMP) Blue Sky Program ("Program") filed on August 5, 2019. The DPU reviewed RMP's reported program revenues and expenses for the year ended December 2018 and evaluated the Program's compliance with pertinent PSC orders and tariff schedules. The DPU determined that the Program's revenues, disbursements, and expenditures appear to be properly stated and that RMP appears to be in compliance with regulatory and reporting requirements. The DPU concludes the Program follows good business practices and uses adequate and practical accounting and controls.

The PSC supports the DPU's efforts to audit RMP's Program to ensure it is operated in compliance with PSC orders and RMP's tariff and to communicate its Audit Report findings.
