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Pursuant to Utah Admin. Code Rule R746-1-108, Utah Clean Energy files this Unopposed Motion to Amend Schedule, requesting that the Public Service Commission (“Commission”) adopt a new date for the technical conference and deadline to submit questions for the technical conference, consistent with the proposed schedule below, and Request for Expedited Review. Utah Clean Energy represents that the Division of Public Utilities, the Office of Consumer Services, Rocky Mountain Power (the “Company”), and Salt Lake City Corporation all support this Motion.

Good cause exists to grant this Motion on an expedited basis. On March 25, 2020, Rocky Mountain Power filed an Unopposed Motion to Revise the Procedural Schedule and Request for Expedited Treatment seeking additional time to prepare and finalize Rocky Mountain Power’s supplemental filing. The Commission granted Rocky Mountain Power’s motion on March 26, 2020, adopting a new schedule for this docket. Consistent with the amended schedule, Rocky Mountain Power filed its supplemental filing and testimony on April 9, 2020. Rocky Mountain

Power’s supplemental filing contains a significant amount analysis, including IRP modelling, in support of several routine updates and one non-routine update. The non-applicant parties would appreciate additional time to review the information in Rocky Mountain Power’s filing to formulate and submit to the Company substantive questions for the upcoming technical conference. Since the deadline to submit questions to the Company in anticipation of the technical conference is tomorrow, April 16, 2020, we ask that the Commission expedite its review of this Motion.

This Motion only proposes to change the deadline for parties to submit questions to Rocky Mountain Power in anticipation of the technical conference, and the date of the technical conference. Specifically, we propose moving the technical conference from April 24, 2020 at 1:00 p.m. to May 8, 2020 at 1:00 p.m., and moving the deadline to submit questions to the Company in advance of the technical conference to May 1, 2020. The proposed new schedule would be as follows:
