On July 10, 2019, the Public Service Commission of Utah (“Commission”) issued its order approving Electric Service Schedule No. 22 – Indoor Agricultural Lighting Tariff (“Schedule 22”) in the above referenced docket (“Order”). The Order directed PacifiCorp (“Company”) to file updates to all surcharge-related electric service schedules to include Schedule 22 within 15 days of the date of the Order. As specified in the rebuttal testimony of Company witness Robert M. Meredith, the applicable Electric Service Schedules are 80, 91, 94, 98, 193, 196, and 197.

Pursuant to the Order, enclosed for filing are tariff sheets associated with Tariff P.S.C.U No. 50 applicable to electric service in the State of Utah. Pursuant to the requirement of Rule R746-405-2(D), PacifiCorp states that the proposed tariff sheets do not constitute a violation of state law or Commission rule. The tariff sheets reflect a proposed effective date of August 1, 2019 to align with the effective date of Schedule 22.


