Dear Ms. Saba:

The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed the September 24 and 26, 2019 filings by Rocky Mountain Power (RMP) proposing modifications to Sheet No. 6R.1 of Electric Service Regulation No. 6, Company's Installation ("Regulation 6"). The proposed modifications include adding Single-phase, 240/480 volts, 3 wire, grounded to the list of secondary service voltages in Section 1 of Regulation 6 and administrative changes. RMP proposes an effective date of January 1, 2020 for these changes.

The PSC also reviewed the comments of the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed on October 7, 2019. The DPU concluded RMP's proposal is a reasonable solution that meets customer needs while mitigating costs and is in the public interest. The DPU recommends the PSC approve RMP's filing.

Based on the PSC's review of RMP's filing and the DPU's comments and recommendation, the proposed revisions to Regulation 6, Sheet No. 6R.1 are approved effective January 1, 2020.
