The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed the October 25, 2019 filing by Rocky Mountain Power (RMP) proposing modifications to Electric Service Schedule Nos. 70 and 72 relating to its Blue Sky Program ("Program"). Specifically, RMP requests to modify Sheet Nos. 70.1, 72.1, and 72.2 of its Tariff P.S.C.U. No. 50, to increase the standard Program block size from 100 kWh to 200 kWh of renewable energy with no increase to the block price. RMP states it is requesting these modifications in an effort to meet growing customer demands in the renewable energy sector and to better align with market conditions. RMP proposes an effective date of January 1, 2020 for these changes.

The PSC also reviewed the November 12, 2019 comments filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) and Utah Clean Energy (UCE). The DPU recommends the PSC approve RMP's proposed changes. UCE states it does not oppose RMP's proposed modifications. UCE recommends RMP communicate this change to existing customers in clear language that explains the impact of the change on a customer's subscription cost and energy offset goals.

Based on the PSC's review of the filing and the DPU's recommendation, the proposed modifications to Electric Service Schedule Sheet Nos. 70.1, 72.1, and 72.2 are approved, effective January 1, 2020. The PCS encourages RMP to communicate this change with its Program customers.
