Dear Mr. Dellinger:

The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed Empire Electric Association's ("Empire") Revision 1 2021 Update of its Wildland Fire Protection Plan ("2021 Plan") filed on April 28, 2021. The PSC also reviewed the May 25, 2021 action request response filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) addressing Empire's 2021 Plan.

DPU recommends the PSC acknowledge Empire's 2021 Plan as complying with Utah Code Ann. § 54-24-203. According to DPU, Empire's updates do not alter the substance of Empire's initial Wildland Fire Protection Plan (WFPP)¹ and rather provide clarifying language. Based on that determination and its review of the 2021 Plan, DPU comments that the 2021 Plan complies with the Act's requirements related to electric cooperatives.

Based on the PSC's review of Empire's 2021 Plan and DPU's comments and recommendation, the PSC acknowledges Empire's 2021 Plan complies with the requirements of Utah Code Ann. § 54-24-203. Accordingly, pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 54-24-203(5), the Plan is available for public inspection at the PSC.
