Wildland Fire Protection Plan.

Recommendation (Acknowledge)

The Division of Public Utilities (Division) recommends that the Public Service Commission (Commission) acknowledge Raft Rive Rural Electric Cooperative (RREC) Wildland Fire Protection Plan (WFPP) as complying with Utah Code § 54-24-203 – Wildland Fire Protection Plan for an Electric Cooperative.

Issue

Re:

Pursuant to Utah Code § 54-24-203, on August 11, 2020, RREC filed its WFPP. On the same day, the Commission issued an Action Request to the Division requesting the Division review RREC's filing for compliance and make recommendations. The Commission asked the Division to report back by September 10, 2020. This memorandum represents the Division's response to the Commission's Action Request.

Discussion

Raft River Rural Electric Cooperative is an electrical distribution cooperative. Utah Code § 54-24-203, requires electric cooperatives to prepare a Wildland Fire Protection Plan. The content of this plan includes procedures for inspections, vegetation management, preventive programs, denergizing power lines, etc. On August 11, 2020, RREC filed its WFPP. The purpose of the filing was to comply with Utah code, protect the public, minimize the chance of the cooperative's power lines starting wildfires, and speed the recovery from any wildfires that may occur.

The Division reviewed the filing and determined that it contains a point by point discussion of the requirements of the code. Therefore, the Division concludes that RREC's filing is in compliance.

Conclusion

Based on its review of RREC's filing, the Division recommends that the Commission acknowledge RREC's filing as complying with Utah Code § 54-24-203.
