Recommendation (Acknowledge)

The Division of Public Utilities (Division) recommends that the Public Service Commission (Commission) acknowledge Dixie Power's Wildland Fire Protection Plan (WFPP) as complying with Utah Code § 54-24-203 – Wildland Fire Protection Plan for an Electric Cooperative.

Issue

Pursuant to Utah Code § 54-24-203, on June 29, 2020, Dixie Power filed its WFPP. On the same day the Commission issued an Action Request to the Division requesting the Division review EEA's filing for compliance and make recommendations. The Commission asked the Division to report back by July 29, 2020. This memorandum represents the Division's response to the Commission's Action Request.

Discussion

Dixie Power is a non-profit rural electric cooperative. Utah Code § 54-24-203, requires electric cooperatives to prepare a Wildland Fire Protection Plan. The content of this plan includes

procedures for inspections, vegetation management, preventive programs, de-energizing power lines, etc. On June 29, 2020, Dixie Power filed its WFPP. The purpose of the filing was to comply with Utah code, protect the public, minimize the chance of the cooperative's power lines starting wildfires, and speed the recovery from any wildfires that may occur.

The Division reviewed the filing and determined that it contains a point by point discussion of the requirements of the code. Therefore, the Division concludes that Dixie Power's filing is in compliance.

Conclusion

Based on its review of Dixie Power's filing , the Division recommends that the Commission acknowledge Dixie Power's filing as complying with Utah Code § 54-24-203.
