Dear Mr. Rasmussen:

The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed Deseret Generation & Transmission Cooperative's ("Deseret") July 19, 2021 filing of its Wildland Fire Protection Plan 2021 Annual Update ("Update"). The Update revises the Wildland Fire Protection Plan ("Plan") that Desert originally filed on July 21, 2020 pursuant to Utah Code Title 54, Chapter 24, Wildland Fire Planning and Cost Recovery Act ("Act"). The PSC also reviewed the August 12, 2021 and September 24, 2021 comments filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU).

DPU comments that the Update includes clarifying language and updated vegetation management procedures, and does not include any substantive changes. DPU further commented that the Update does not constitute an annual compliance filing under Utah Code Ann. § 54-24-203(4), but does comply with the Act's requirements for a wildland fire protection plan. Accordingly, DPU recommends that the PSC acknowledge the Update.

Based on the PSC's review of the Update and DPU's comments and recommendations, the PSC acknowledges the Update as complying with the Act's requirements for a Wildland Fire Protection Plan. Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 54-24-203(5), the Update is available for public inspection at the PSC.
