Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 63-46b-9 and Rule R746-100-7, Utah Department of Natural Resources hereby moves this Commission for leave to intervene in these proceedings. In support of this Petition, the Department of Natural Resources, hereinafter the "Department", states as follows:

1. The chief administrative officer of the Department of Natural Resources is designated by Utah Code Ann. § 63-34-5 with responsibility to coordinate state functions regarding energy development, to facilitate development and implementation of policies and programs relating to energy, and to participate in regulatory proceedings as appropriate to the functions and duties of the Department.

2. The proceedings in this matter will affect the policy and programs of the state of Utah as an energy user.

3. The rulings and proceedings pursuant to this Petition will affect the policy and development of energy production in the state of Utah, and the participation of the Department is appropriate in order to facilitate development of a policy consistent with the best interests of the State.

4. The Executive Director has delegated to the Office of Energy and Resource Planning his responsibilities under § 63-34-5 above and will participate in these proceedings through the representation by that Office.

WHEREFORE, the Executive Director of the Utah Department of Natural Resources requests leave to intervene in these proceedings to protect its interests as they may appear through the representation by the Office of Energy and Resource Planning.
