Pursuant to Revised Scheduling Order and Notice of Pre-hearing Conference issued August 10, 2001, a scheduling conference was held in the above-referenced matter on August 29, 2001. The parties held a lengthy off-the-record discussion. During the course of the discussion, the Division of Public Utilities ("Division") provided two documents to the parties which were later filed with the Commission: Suggested Issues to be Decided in Phase I and Suggested Technical Conference Agenda. Based upon these documents and a preliminary agreement about certain aspects of a schedule for the first phase of the docket, the parties have preliminarily agreed that the docket could be conducted in two phases with the first phase addressing issues such as those set forth on the Division's Suggested Issues as modified based upon further input from the parties and the Commission and further agreed upon a preliminary schedule and procedures as follows.

The Commission has reviewed the agreement of the parties and finds the same to be in the public interest.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that:

- 1. The parties may file comments, clarifications and additions to the Division's Suggested Issues to be Decided in Phase I and Suggested Technical Conference Agenda not later than September 5, 2001 setting forth issues to be considered by the Commission and decided in Phase I of this docket and the issues to be addressed at the next technical conference.
- 2. The Division shall compile and consolidate the comments, clarifications and additions received from the parties and shall file a consolidated statement of the issues for Phase I and a consolidated agenda for the next technical conference by September 11, 2001.
- 3. Any party may file objections or clarifications to the Division's September 11, 2001 filings not later than September 14, 2001.
- 4. A further scheduling conference is scheduled before the Commission commencing at 10:30 a.m. on Wednesday, September 19, 2001, in the Commission's main hearing room, Room 426, Heber M. Wells Building, 160 East 300 South, Salt Lake City, Utah, to set dates for further proceedings in this docket.
- 5. Prior to the September 19, 2001 scheduling conference, the parties shall attempt to agree upon a proposed schedule. If the parties have not reached agreement prior to September 19, 2001, they shall meet at 9:30 a.m. on Wednesday, September 19, 2001, in Room 427, Heber M. Wells Building, 160 East 300 South, Salt Lake City, Utah, to attempt to reach agreement.
 - 6. Service of all filings in this docket shall be by electronic mail ("e-mail") where possible as well as by personal

delivery, overnight courier or United States mail.

- 7. Responses to data requests shall be served upon the party serving the requests, and upon any other party requesting and entitled to receive a copy, within 20 days of the date the requests are received by the responding party.
