## PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On May 11, 2001, the Commission issued its Order in this matter, requiring PacifiCorp to initiate a 10/10 customer challenge plan *in conjunction* with its proposed 20/20 customer challenge plan. Pursuant to said Order, PacifiCorp filed proposed first revised Sheet No. 2020 to its Utah tariff 43. Analysis of the proposed sheet discloses two infirmities, to wit: 1) The 10/10 program is rendered effective July 1, 2001, a month later than the 20/20 program -- this is not *in conjunction* with the latter as we contemplated; and 2) The language in the proposed tariff sheet is ambiguous as to the exact terms of the two programs. Based on these infirmities, the Commission issues the following

## **ORDER**

## NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that:

- 1. Owing to the lateness in the season, the Commission will permit PacifiCorp to make the 10/10 program effective July 1, 2001, with a term running from July 1, 2001, through September 30, 2001. In regard to the 20/20 program, the effective date remains June 1, 2001, with a term running from that date through September 30, 2001.
- 2. PacifiCorp's proposed Tariff Page 2020 be, and it is, rejected; to cure its infirmities, PacifiCorp will immediately file an amended page 2020 with language explicitly setting forth the respective terms of the two programs.
- 3. Any person aggrieved by this Order may petition the Commission for review within 20 days of the date of this Order. Failure so to do will forfeit the right to appeal to the Utah Supreme Court.
