By The Commission:

Complainant filed her formal complaint in this matter on July 11, 2002. PacifiCorp responded on August 7, 2002, with an Answer to Formal Complaint. On August 8, 2002, PacifiCorp filed a request for an expedited hearing. The Commission attempted to schedule a hearing, but due to medical reasons related to Complainant's pregnancy, no hearing was immediately scheduled. On August 27, 2002, PacifiCorp filed a Motion to Dismiss for Mootness. The grounds for the motion are that PacifiCorp committed that it will not withhold or terminate electrical service to Complainant because PacifiCorp had determined that it had written-off the entire disputed amount when the co-account holder filed bankruptcy.

On the basis that this matter has been settled, we enter the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that:

1. The Complaint of Crystal Lee Hurtado against PacifiCorp is dismissed.
2. If any party wishes to proceed further, it may file a written petition for review within 20 days of the date of this Order. Failure to do so will forfeit the right to appeal to the Utah Supreme Court.
