SYNOPSIS

The Commission grants a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing Utah Associated Municipal Power Systems ("UAMPS") to construct and operate a 140 MW natural gas-fired power plant, and associated transmission facilities. The power plant will be located in Payson, Utah. The power plant and associated transmission facilities are hereafter referred to as the "Payson Project."

By The Commission:

It has come to the attention of the Commission that there is an error in the recent Report and Order sent by the Commission on January 15, 2003. The last sentence in the third paragraph on page eight states, 'The Committee recommends issuance of a certificate approving construction of the proposed power plant and associated transmission facilities.' The correct paragraph should read, 'The Committee has no objections to the project or to the issuance of a certificate.'
