ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

ISSUED: January 22, 2004

By The Commission:

On December 11, 2003, Utah Power & Light ("PacifiCorp") submitted a tariff filing regarding Schedule 113 - Cool Cash Incentive Program. The Division of Public Utilities ("Division") was asked to investigate and report its recommendations by December 24, 2003. Prior to that date both the Division and the Committee of Consumer Services ("Committee") requested an additional two weeks to complete their analyses. The Division also requested that the tariff be suspended until it completed its analysis. On January 5, 2004, we suspended the tariff and extended the deadline for responses to the proposed tariff by two weeks.

On January 7, 2004, the Division and the Committee filed comments on the proposed tariff. The Division recommended approval of the tariff as filed. The Committee recommended some wording changes to clarify the optional sizing incentive.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the proposed PacifiCorp tariff filing is approved subject to the following wording changes on sheet 113.2:

1. Insert "(CAC)" after "Central air conditioning" in the first sentence.
2. Replace the word "requirement" with "incentive" in the first sentence of the third paragraph.
3. Replace "12 SEER" with "12-12.9 SEER" in Table 1A.
