A status conference was conducted telephonically by the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ), Ruben Arredondo, on Thursday, December 18, 2008. Mr. Ted Reynolds (Reynolds), the complainant, appeared telephonically. Appearing for the Rocky Mountain Power (Company) were counsel, were Ms. Barbara Ishimatsu, counsel, Ms. Barbara Coughlin, director, customer services and regulatory liaison, and Mr. Kurt Jensen, Regulatory Analyst.

The Company represented that it had commenced much of the tree-trimming process and other work designed to improve reliability on the Coalville #12 Feeder, which provides service to Reynolds. Additionally, on December 17, 2008, the Company submitted a summary of the work that had been done on the Coalville #12 Feeder, along with a list of all work order numbers associated with this circuit work along with the completion date for the individual work order. Reynolds had several specific questions with regards items listed in individual headings, e.g. "Cutout, Lightening Arrester and Mounting Arm Change Outs", "Deadend Insulator Change Outs", "Resag Conductor", etc. The questions were beyond the knowledge or expertise of the company representatives appearing. To provide the Company an opportunity to respond to Reynolds's questions, and also to provide time to determine how the company's work has improved reliability, the Commission makes the following order regarding scheduling in this docket:

- 1. Mr. Reynolds shall state, in writing, what further information he seeks related to the work that was done and listed in the Company's December 17, 2008 letter.
- Based on the scope of the information requested by Mr. Reynolds, the Commission will issue a deadline for the Company's response;
