DISPOSITION: Questar passed out a proposed schedule and indicated that not all parties had agreed. Reed Warnick, Attorney for the CCS said the Committee needs additional time to hire consultants and prepare for this case, the following schedule was agreed upon:

May 3, 2002- Case filed by Questar Gas Company

August 28, 2002- Prepared responsive testimony by all other parties other than Questar

October 2, 2002- Prepared rebuttal testimony by Questar Gas & intervenors

October 11, 2002- Prepared surrebuttal testimony

October 17- 18, 2002- Hearings

October 21-22, 2002- Hearings

October 25,28, 2002- Hearing hold over dates, if necessary

October 22, 2002- Public Witness day at 4:30 p.m.

December 29, 2002- Order due because 240 days expire

The parties agreed to work out settlement dates which will not involve the Commissioners. It was also agreed that parties will make best efforts on a 14 day turnaround until August 28th and a 10 day turnaround thereafter.

There was a discussion on the appropriate test year to examine for this docket. It was determined that a test year hearing should be held on May 28, 2002 at 10:00 a.m. in Rm 426. The hearing will be both a legal and factual discussion of these test year issues.

The chairman requested that Mr. Gary Sackett, Attorney for Questar Gas prepare an order reflecting today's discussion and the final schedule.
