**Re: Docket No. 07-057-13 - QGC Cross 8**

Dear Commissioners:

During the hearing yesterday in the Questar Gas Company (“Questar Gas”) general rate case, Docket No. 07-057-13, Questar Gas used a two-page document including the cover page and page 61 of a research report by Lehman Brothers titled Power & Utilities and dated May 22, 2007 in the cross examination of Charles E. Peterson. The cross examination questions related to investors’ expectations for the rate of return on equity that would be allowed in a pending rate case decision before the Public Regulation Commission in New Mexico for Public Service Company of New Mexico (“PNM”). The document was marked as QGC Cross 8. When offered, the Committee of Consumer Services (“Committee”) objected to admission of the exhibit based on a concern that additional relevant information may have been omitted. Questar Gas agreed to provide a complete copy of the document to the parties for review, and the Commission withheld its ruling on the offer and objection pending this review.

Subsequently, just prior to conclusion of the hearing, Questar Gas provided a complete copy of the document for the review of the Commission and the parties. Questar Gas proposed to also include page 62 in the exhibit so that the entire portion of the report discussing PNM Resources, the parent company of PNM, would be included in the exhibit. The Committee accepted that proposal and stated that it would not object to introduction of the exhibit with that change. The Commission then admitted QGC Cross 8 into evidence.

Consistent with its proposal, Questar Gas hereby provides five copies of the complete exhibit for the Commission’s files. In addition, a color pdf of the complete exhibit showing the
