Subject: Questar Gas Tariff Filing, Docket No. 09-057-T04

ISSUE:

Questar Gas Company (QGC) filed on May 11, 2009, revised tariff sheets for Section 2.12, Therm-Wise Multi-Family Rebates Program and Section 2.15, Therm-Wise Weatherization Program of their Utah Natural Gas Tariff PSCU 400.

RECOMMEND APPROVAL:

The Division has reviewed the revised tariff sheets and recommends approval as filed.

DISCUSSION:

QGC has filed the revised tariff sheets in compliance with the Commission order issued March 31, 2009 in Docket No. 09-057-T04, In the Matter of the Application for Tariff Change for Third-year Budget for Demand Side Management Programs and Market Transformation Initiative.



In the application, a request was made by the Company to reduce the rebate amounts for both the Attic Insulation and Floor Insulation measures from \$0.35 to \$0.20 per square foot and reduce the Wall Insulation from \$0.45 to \$0.30 per square foot in the Therm-Wise Multi-Family and Weatherization Programs with an effective date of April 1, 2009.

After holding a hearing on March 26, 2009, the Commission granted the request in an order issued on March 31, 2009, changing the effective date of the request to May 2, 2009.

The Division has reviewed the tariff sheets and the changes, as ordered by the Commission, are reflected in the revised tariff sheets with an effective date of May 2, 2009. The Division recommends approval of the revised tariff sheets for Section 2.12 and Section 2.15 of the Questar Gas Company Utah Natural Gas Tariff PSCU 400 as filed.
