By The Commission:

The above-captioned matters pertain to rate applications filed by Questar Gas Company ("Questar") on December 29, 2011. As presented by Questar, the Energy Efficiency Deferred Account application will lower the typical GS residential customer's annual bill by about \$2.59 (0.39%). The Infrastructure Rate Adjustment application will raise the typical GS residential customer's annual bill by \$1.98 (0.30%). In combination, these applications, if approved, will have the combined net effect of slightly lowering the annual bills of such customers.

A hearing on these applications is hereby scheduled for Thursday, January 19, 2012, at 10:00 a.m., Room 451, Heber M. Wells Bldg., 160 East 300 South, Salt Lake City, Utah 84111. The hearing will take place before a presiding officer designated by the Commission.
