I. BACKGROUND

On or about August 29, 2013, John Asson (“Mr. Asson”) filed a formal complaint in this docket against Questar Gas Company (“Questar”), alleging billing irregularities and requesting an adjustment related to work done on his meter.¹ On September 6, 2013, the Commission noticed this matter for hearing on October 1, 2013, at 2:00 p.m.² On September 16, 2013, Mr. Asson sent an e-mail to the Commission, noting he did “not have enough empirical evidence to [support his complaint and] warrant the [expenditure] of . . . time” and requesting the “hearing be cancelled.” E-mail from John Asson, to Commission (Sep. 16, 2013, 10:29 MDT).³ The Commission reads Mr. Asson’s e-mail as a motion to withdraw his complaint.

II. ORDER

Based on Mr. Asson’s withdrawal of his complaint, and for other good cause appearing, the complaint is dismissed.⁴ Accordingly, the hearing previously scheduled for **Tuesday, October 1, 2013, beginning at 2:00 p.m.**, is cancelled.

Notice of Opportunity for Agency Review or Rehearing

Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. §§ 63G-4-301 and 54-7-15, a party may seek agency review or rehearing of this order by filing a request for review or rehearing with the Commission within 30 days after the issuance of the order. Responses to a request for agency review or rehearing must be filed within 15 days of the filing of the request for review or rehearing. If the Commission fails to grant a request for review or rehearing within 20 days after the filing of a request for review or rehearing, it is deemed denied. Judicial review of the Commission's final agency action may be obtained by filing a Petition for Review with the Utah Supreme Court within 30 days after final agency action. Any Petition for Review must comply with the requirements of Utah Code Ann. §§ 63G-4-401, 63G-4-403, and the Utah Rules of Appellate Procedure.
