### PROCEDURAL HISTORY

This matter is before the Public Service Commission of Utah on Questar Gas
Company's ("QGC") September 8, 2014, Application to Make Tariff Modifications

("Application") to the ThermWise® Builder Rebates Program, Section 2.11 of the Questar Gas
Company Utah Natural Gas Tariff PSCU 400 ("Tariff"). QGC states the Application is submitted
in order to implement the rebate credit component of the ThermWise® Builder Rebates Program.

The Application requests an effective date of October 8, 2014, for the proposed tariff
modifications.

Pursuant to the Commission's September 10, 2014, notice of filing and comment period, the Office of Consumer Services ("Office") filed comments on September 23, 2014, and the Division of Public Utilities ("Division") filed comments on September 24, 2014, recommending approval of QGC's Application. No reply comments were filed.

### DISCUSSION, FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS

The Division and the Office both indicate QGC's Application complies with the Commission's directive provided in its January 2, 2014, order in this docket ("January 2014 Order"). In that order, we approved the ThermWise® Builder Rebates program, except for the

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necessary modifications to implement the rebate credit language pertaining to the rebate credit. The January 2014 Order directed QGC to file for approval of necessary modifications to its Tariff thirty days prior to implementation of the ThermWise® Builder Rebates program rebate credit. Both the Division and the Office reviewed the proposed tariff modifications and recommend the Commission approve them as filed. Based upon our review of the Application and the recommendations provided by the Division and the Office, we find the proposed modifications to Section 2.11 of the Tariff to be in the public interest and consistent with our January 2014 Order and therefore approve them, effective October 8, 2014.

### **ORDER**

Pursuant to the discussion, findings and conclusions, we order:

QGC's proposed changes to Section 2.11 of its Tariff as filed with the

Commission with its September 8, 2014, Application, are approved effective October 8, 2014.
