In our IRP meeting last week you had a couple of questions. One was about the calculation of CNG pump prices and one was about the number of days that we used NNT service. I have attached a press release that we have on our website that should answer question number one. We switched to the new CNG calculation at the beginning of the year. The following is the corrected information on No-Notice usage from section 7 of the IRP.

Questar Gas utilized its NNT almost every day throughout the 2013/2014 heating season. There were 7 days that NNT was not used due to capacity allocations at Clay Basin. Questar Gas used NNT service 86 days during the heating season to reduce nominations by reducing withdrawals or injecting into storage. Questar Gas used NNT the 58 days to provide for additional storage withdrawal. The maximum daily storage withdrawal reduction for the heating season was 155,333 Dth with an average daily withdrawal reduction of 56,156 Dth. The maximum daily storage withdrawal increase for the heating season was 203,542 Dth with an average daily increase of 81,736 Dth.
