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ISSUED: August 8, 2014

On August 7, 2014, Questar Gas Company ("QGC") filed a motion to amend the scheduling order and notices of technical conference and hearing issued in this docket on July 1, 2014 ("Scheduling Order"). QGC states the Scheduling Order requires that a complaint be filed by July 10, 2014, but did not set forth a deadline for QGC to file an answer to the complaint. QGC notes that if it filed an answer 30 days after the complaint, it would be due August 11, 2014.
