Dear Mr. McKay,

On November 25, 2014, the Commission held a hearing in this docket to consider Questar's application to change the infrastructure rate adjustment. During the hearing, it was determined that the tariff sheets originally filed with the application should have reflected the cost-of-service allocation approved by the Commission in Questar's most recent depreciation rate case in Docket No. 13-057-19,¹ as opposed to the cost-of-service allocations approved by the Commission in Questar's most recent No. 13-057-05.² Questar agreed to refile the proposed tariff sheets reflecting the appropriate allocation factors.

At the conclusion of the hearing, the Commission issued a bench ruling approving the rates contained in the application, on an interim basis, subject to Questar's commitment to file revised tariff sheets reflecting the appropriate cost-of-service allocation.

Pursuant to the Commission's request, Questar filed a submission of supplemental information and updated tariff sheets on November 25, 2014. The filing includes revised tariff sheets reflecting the cost-of-service allocation established in Questar's depreciation rate case in Docket No. 13-057-19. Questar states the Division of Public Utilities (Division) reviewed the rates for

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accuracy at Questar's offices and is authorized to represent that the Division does not oppose the approval of the tariff sheets included in the filing and the rates set forth therein, on an interim basis, subject to the Division's audit.

Based on the foregoing and for good cause shown, the Commission approves the tariff sheets filed with the Commission on November 25, 2014, with an effective date of December 1, 2014.
