Subject: Docket 14-057-T05, In the Matter of the Application of Questar Gas Company for Authority to File a Change in its Existing Tariff

**RE: Request for Amended Comment Period and Order Suspending Tariff**

The Office of Consumer Services (Office) requests that the Public Service Commission (Commission) extend the comment period for Docket 14-057-T05 from July 25, 2014 to October 15, 2014 for initial comments extend the reply period to October 24, 2014, and that the Commission suspends the proposed tariff changes pursuant to Utah Admin. Code R746-405-2.E.4a.

This filing represents changes to the tariff sufficiently complex for the Office to issue a data request to clarify proposed language in the tariff. The Office has been in discussions with the Company regarding its data needs and despite the Company's agreement for a quick turnaround, the current timing is not sufficient to allow for adequate analysis prior to the comment due date. The Office is requesting the additional

time in order to thoroughly review the proposed changes and the Company's data request responses.

The Office has discussed the extension with Questar Gas Company (Company) and the Division of Public Utilities (Division), who agreed that the complexity of the changes warranted additional time for discussion and review. The proposed new comment dates were developed jointly by all three parties and are supported by the Company and the Division.
