Dear Mr. McKay:

The Public Service Commission of Utah ("Commission") has received Questar Gas Company's ("Questar") Report Concerning Questar Gas Company's Acquisition of the Eagle Mountain City Natural Gas System ("Report") filed pursuant to Utah Administrative Code ("UAC") R746-401. Specifically, Questar reports to the Commission that it intends to acquire natural gas distribution assets from Eagle Mountain City on or after February 23, 2015, for \$11.4 million. Questar intends to become the natural gas distribution provider to Eagle Mountain City's customers.

On February 23, 2015, the Commission received an action request response from the Division of Public Utilities ("Division"), providing its review of the Report and recommendations. Based on its review, the Division concludes: 1) The \$11.4 million acquisition meets the threshold value triggering the reporting requirements in UAC R746-401-3, and 2) the Report meets the UAC R746-401-3, subsections A, D, and E reporting requirements. The Division also notes the acquisition will not impact existing customers' rates at this time. The Division states the prudence of the acquisition will be examined in the next general rate case. Therefore, the Division recommends the Commission take no action at this time.

Based on the Division's review, the Commission acknowledges Questar's Report complies with the reporting requirements in UAC R746-401-3, subsections A, D, and E.
