### Background

On September 24, 2015, the Company met with representatives from the Division of Public Utilities (“DPU” or “Division”) and the Office of Consumer Services (“Office”) to discuss a correction to the Company’s filing prior to hearing. The “Reduction for Interruptible Penalty” credit in the Infrastructure Rate Adjustment revenue requirement calculation was overstated by \$57,438 due to inclusion of SNG and commodity components which should not have been included. During the hearing, the Company indicated that they would provide updated tariff sheets reflecting the adjustment. The

Office has reviewed the updated exhibits provided by the Company during the hearing and the tariff sheets provided on September 24<sup>th</sup> and concurs that the tariff sheets reflect the changes approved during the hearing by bench order.
