On Jan. 6, 2017, Dominion initiated an interruption of non-firm service and provided notice to all of its interruptible sales and interruptible (non-firm) transportation customers to interrupt their usage. According to the DPU, 286 of 603 Interruptible customers that were served the notice of interruption failed to do so, incurring the surcharge and penalty as dictated by Dominion Energy

- The order or notice, including any deadlines, shall supersede and replace this action request; and
- This action request shall be deemed withdrawn.
