The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed the May 16, 2018 filing by Dominion Energy Utah (Dominion) of updates relating to its Infrastructure Rate Adjustment Mechanism Pilot Program (Filing). The Filing was made pursuant to paragraph 22.b of the Partial Settlement Stipulation (Stipulation) approved by the PSC on February 21, 2014 in Docket No. 13-057-05.

The PSC also reviewed the June 22, 2018 action request response filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU). The DPU concludes Dominion has materially met the requirements of the Stipulation and identifies no apparent material changes. Therefore, the DPU recommends the PSC acknowledge Dominion's compliance with paragraph 22 of the Stipulation.

Based on the PSC's review of the Filing and the DPU's comments, the PSC acknowledges that Dominion's Filing complies with the requirements of paragraph 22.b of the Stipulation.
