Pursuant to Section 8.08 of Dominion Energy Utah's Natural Gas Tariff PSCU 500 ("Tariff"): "Only entities that are authorized by and maintain authorization from the Utah Insurance Department [] to operate as a "service contract provider" pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 31A-6a-101 et seq. and the applicable administrative rules in Utah, [...] may be eligible to contract with Dominion Energy for the use of third party billing services."

The Utah Department of Insurance's online Insurance Company and Agency Search function¹ appears to indicate that both Dominion Products and Services, Inc. ("DPS") and HomeServe USA Repair Management Corp ("HomeServe") currently are authorized "home warranty" companies. The Insurance Company and Agency Search function also appears to indicate that authorizations for both entities as "service contract provider" are "Inactive."

Relating to the authorization required in DEU's Tariff Section 8.08, please provide the "home warranty" and the "service contract provider" authorization status histories from the Utah Insurance Department for both DPS and HomeServe beginning July 28, 2017 through the present.²
