(By Ms. Clark) Mr. Stephenson, can you summarize the relief the company is seeking in this 10 11 application? 12 Α. Yes. In this docket the company seeks to 13 adjust the infrastructure tracker replacement rate to include investment related to replacement projects that 14 were in service as of August 31, 2018. The majority of 15 this additional investment occurred in the Feeder Line 16 21 project in Davis County. 17 The company is requesting a 3 and a half 18 million dollar increase in annual revenue related to 19 20 this investment, resulting in a total annual revenue 21 requirement of 25.6 million dollars. If approved, this 22 would result in an increase of 2 dollars and 45 cents 23 per year or .39 percent paid by a typical customer using 80 decatherms per year. 24 25 Does that conclude your summary? Q.

In summary, the gas utility's Α. proposal is a total revenue requirement in the 8 9 infrastructure tracker of 25.62 million dollars or an incremental revenue requirement increase of 3.515 10 11 million dollars from the current interim revenue 12 requirement of 22.105 million dollars. 13 If approved, a typical GS customer would see an annual increase of 2 dollars and 45 cents or 0.39 14 15 This application complies with past commission percent. 16 orders, and proposed tariff sheets reflect the changes as filed by the gas utility. 17 The division has reviewed the filing, along 18 with the respective exhibits, and tentatively agrees 19 20 with the methods used. Therefore, the division 21 recommends the commission approve the proposed rates on 2.2 an interim basis until the division can complete its audit, at which time it will make a final recommendation 23 24 to the commission. That's all I have. Thank you. 25 PRESIDING OFFICER LEVAR: Okay.
