This is a request for the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) to provide analysis, evaluation results, and the basis for conclusions and recommendations regarding the following:

- Review for Compliance and Make Recommendations
- Review Application and Make Recommendations
- Review the Complaint and Indicate whether DPU has a Recommendation
- Review Notice and Make Recommendations
- Review Request for Agency Action and Make Recommendations
- Respond in Accordance with the Notice of Filing and Request for Comments
- Investigate
- Other – Explanation and Statement of Issues to be Addressed (See Below):

- 1) Tab Other Inputs, Row 32, of DEU’s filed spreadsheet named “DEU Pass-Thru Model 10-1-2018,” identifies a 12-month transportation contract labeled “T-1 Transportation Yearly (Hyrum)” for 100,000 Dth. The cost for the contract (\$6,345,648 on a system basis) is identified in Tab SDR#2, cell F37. The volumes and costs for this contract are included in the QPC Demand for T-1 Transportation section of Tab Ut 1.3 p1, Cells F17 and L17, respectively. Please investigate whether the inclusion of this contract in Docket No. 18-057-14 is in compliance with DEU’s Tariff Section Gas Balancing Account Adjustment Provision, 191 Account Entries.
- 2) On pages 10-1 and 10-2 of Dominion’s 2018 IRP it states “. . . the Company also signed a Precedent Agreement to upgrade the Hyrum Gate station and expand the total capacity by 100,000 Dth/D[ay]. . . DEQP will complete the upgrades in 2019 and the capacity will be available for the 2019-2020 heating season.” Please investigate whether the service represented by T-1 Transportation Yearly (Hyrum) transportation contract will be available/used and useful during the test period in this docket.
