8	hearing. Can we please start with appearances.
9	MS. CLARK: Jenniffer Clark on behalf
10	of Dominion Energy Utah, and I have with me Jordan
11	Stevenson. He will serve as the Company's witness
12	today.
13	MR. JETTER: Good morning. I'm
14	Justin Jetter with the Utah Attorney General's
15	Office, and I'm here today representing the Utah
16	Division of Public Utilities. At counsel table is
17	Division technical consultant Eric Orton.
18	OFFICER REIF: Thank you. Welcome,
19	everyone. Ms. Clark, would you like to proceed?
20	MS. CLARK: The Company calls
21	Mr. Stevenson.
22	JORDAN STEVENSON,
23	having been first duly sworn to tell the truth, was
24	examined and testified as follows:
25	BY MS. CLARK:

1	Page 5 Q Could you please state your name and
2	business address for the record, please?
3	A Jordan Stevenson, 333 South State.
4	Q And can you describe your responsibilities
5	with the Company?
6	A I'm a regulatory affairs analyst for
7	Dominion Energy Utah.
8	Q And, Mr. Stevenson, was the application
9	and accompanying Exhibits 1.1 through 1.5 in this
10	docket, were those prepared by you or under your
11	direction?
12	A Yes.
13	Q And do you adopt the contents of those
14	documents as your testimony today?
15	A Yes.
16	MS. CLARK: The Company would move
17	for the admission of the application and
18	accompanying Exhibits 1.1 through 1.5.
19	MR. JETTER: No objection.
20	BY MS. CLARK:
21	Q Thank you. Mr. Stevenson, do you have a
22	summary you'd like to present today?
23	A I do. In this docket, the Company seeks
24	to adjust the infrastructure tracker replacement
25	rate to include investment related to replacement

Page 6 1 projects that were in service as of October 31st, 2 2018. The majority of this additional investment 3 occurred in the feeder line 21 replacement projects 4 in Davis County. The Company is requesting a \$7 million increase in annual revenue related to 5 this investment, resulting in a total annual revenue 6 requirement of \$32.6 million. If approved, this 7 would result in an increase of \$5.21 per year, or 8 9 .87 percent, paid by a typical customer using 80 decatherms per year. This concludes my summary. 10 11 MS. CLARK: The Company's witness is 12 available for Commission questions and 13 cross-examination. 14 MR. JETTER: No questions from the Division. 15 16 OFFICER REIF: Thank you. Mr. Stevenson, I have a question which your counsel 17 may wish to clarify, and that's fine. Just for 18 clarification on what would be page 4 of the 19 2.0 application at the very bottom of the page, the 21 second "wherefore" clause requests the effective 2.2 date to be December 1, 2018. For Commission clarification, could you please let us know whether 23 you're asking for final or interim rates. And if 24

you need to defer to counsel, that's okay.

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Page 9 1 now proposes to collect the revenue requirement 2 associated with this additional investment in 3 routing rates. 4 In addition to the \$25.620 million that it 5 is already allowed in rates on an interim basis, this increase would provide a total revenue 6 requirement of \$32.625 million. Based on the 7 Division's review, the application is compliant, 8 just, reasonable, in the public interest, and 9 10 therefore we recommend that the application be 11 approved on an interim basis until the Division can 12 complete an audit at which time, we'll make a final 13 recommendation to the Commission. That's all I have. Thank you. 14 15 MR. JETTER: Thank you. I have no further questions for Mr. Orton. He's available for 16 17 cross or questions from the Commission. OFFICER REIF: Ms. Clark? 18 19 MS. CLARK: The Company has no 2.0 questions. Thanks. 21 OFFICER REIF: Thank you for your 2.2 testimony, Mr. Orton.
